


How to add device to APP

Description: You will learn how to add device to APP by this document


Step1 Activate the camera


The default IP address of the Tiandy camera is 192.168.1.2, first time when you login camera's website, you need to set password for it



Step2 Enable P2Pfunction

For our camera, spark, superlite, lite series don't support enable P2P function & ONVIF together, so when you use P2P, you need enable it at website
Click QR cord icon, follow the hint, you will enable P2P










Step3 add camera at APP

Scan first QR cord to download app

Use our APP scan second QR code, you can add device



After these steps, you can see the camera at your APP

Note:

- 1.For the NVR, we have two places to show the QR cord, website page & Ui page, both of them at the preview page
- 2.The way to add NVR is same as camera, there is no need to enable P2P for NVR, because default setting is enabled
- 3.If your device doesn't show the second QR cord and the network without

issue, please try to change the MTU to 1400
